**From the OSSTF Provincial Constitution Regulation 2.2.1.8 Duties of Members to OSSTF**

**2.2.1.8** It shall be the duty of every Member who holds elected or appointed office with OSSTF to refrain from holding or seeking office with another union where the interests of the union are in conflict, or appear to be in conflict, with the interests of OSSTF.

**2.2.1.9** It shall be the duty of every Member who is seeking office in OSSTF and who is also a member of another union to declare such dual membership.
